### Materials You'll Need:

- Approximately 100 grams of worsted weight yarn in your desired color
- Size 5 (3.75mm) circular knitting needles, 16 inches long
- Size 6 (4mm) circular knitting needles, 16 inches long

- Cable needle
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

## **Step-by-Step Instructions:**

### **Cast On:**

Using the size 5 circular knitting needles, cast on 112 stitches. Join the stitches in the round, making sure not to twist them.

### **Ribbing:**

Knit 1 round. Purl 1 round. Repeat these two rounds for a total of 2 inches.

### **Cable Pattern:**

Switch to the size 6 circular knitting needles. Follow the cable pattern below:

- Round 1: Slip 2 stitches to the cable needle and hold them at the back of your work. Knit 2 stitches. Transfer the stitches from the cable needle back to the left-hand needle and knit them. Knit to the end of the round.
- Round 2: Purl to the end of the round.
- Round 3: Knit to the end of the round.
- Round 4: Slip 2 stitches to the cable needle and hold them at the front of your work. Knit 2 stitches. Transfer the stitches from the cable needle back to the left-hand needle and knit them. Knit to the end of the round.

- Round 5: Purl to the end of the round.
- Round 6: Knit to the end of the round.
- Round 7: Slip 2 stitches to the cable needle and hold them at the back of your work. Knit 2 stitches. Transfer the stitches from the cable needle back to the left-hand needle and knit them. Knit to the end of the round.
- Round 8: Purl to the end of the round.
- Round 9: Knit to the end of the round.

Repeat these 9 rounds until the hat measures approximately 5 inches from the cast on edge.

### **Crown Shaping:**

Begin shaping the crown by decreasing stitches every other round. Follow the steps below:

- Round 1: \*Knit 10, slip 2 stitches to the cable needle and hold them at the back of your work, knit 2 stitches, transfer the stitches from the cable needle back to the left-hand needle and knit them, knit 10. Repeat from \* around.
- Round 2: Knit to the end of the round.
- Round 3: \*Knit 9, slip 2 stitches to the cable needle and hold them at the back of your work, knit 2 stitches, transfer the stitches from the cable needle back to the left-hand needle and knit them, knit 9. Repeat from \* around.
- Round 4: Knit to the end of the round.

- Round 5: \*Knit 8, slip 2 stitches to the cable needle and hold them at the back of your work, knit 2 stitches, transfer the stitches from the cable needle back to the left-hand needle and knit them, knit 8. Repeat from \* around.
- Round 6: Knit to the end of the round.
- Continue decreasing stitches every other round in this manner until you have only 8 stitches remaining.

### **Bind Off:**

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of about 6 inches. Thread the tail through the remaining 8 stitches and pull tight to bind them off.

### **Finishing:**

Weave in any loose ends using the tapestry needle. To create a brim, fold the bottom edge of the hat up about 1 inch and sew it in place.

### **Tips for Success:**

- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round.
- When knitting the cables, make sure to keep the stitches on the cable needle taut.
- If you're a beginner, practice the cable stitch on a swatch of yarn before starting the hat.
- Don't be afraid to experiment with different colors and yarn weights to create a unique look.

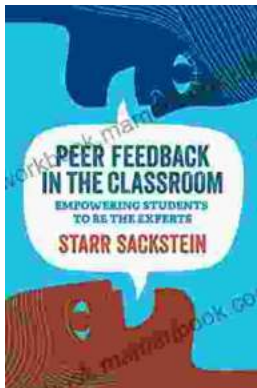


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
